MEMBERSHIP REPORT FOR APRIL 25, 2015 MEETING OF THE LLCNPC

The following actions were taken by the Membership Chairperson since the January 2015 meeting:

- 1. Comparison of current membership listing with mailing labels shows:
 - a. The mailing label list has 497 names. 172 of these names **ARE NOT** on our LLCNPC database.
 - Our LLCNPC database has 439 names. 139 of these names ARE NOT listed as property owners.

There are several reasons why they don't match – properties have changed hands, property owners may not have decided to join, properties are rented or leased to other persons who have decided to become a member of the LLCNPC. There are many names on the current database which are not active and have not been active for some time. They are being kept as a reference only and in due time can be eliminated once a solid listing is made and being monitored on a routine basis.

RECOMMENDATION: Do not make any deletions to the database until we have established a solid list and know for sure that those who have not renewed are no longer owners or able to become a member.

2. Review of 18 returned newsletters mailed 12/23/2014 against current membership listing show that several members have mail forwarded and their forwarding info has expired with the postal service. Some of these returns have no explanation for the return.

RECOMMENDATION: None. Notations to database have been made to monitor.

- 3. Review of Membership guidelines in the By Laws of the LLCNPC (Article 2. Membership):
 - a. Members will consist of each resident within the prescribed boundaries who is 18 years of age or older and who has paid the annual membership dues of \$5.00.
 - b. A Lake Louise Community resident is one who owns real property or has a written lease, license or rental agreement for real property within the boundaries of the Lake Louise Community or whose primary residence has been within the boundaries of the Lake Louise Community for at least one year.

RECOMMENDATION: The current membership form does not reflect that the applicant has any residential rights to membership. This is addressed on the revised form (see item #4 below).

4. Reformat of the Membership Form for approval by the Board. This form to be effective immediately to have membership for a full year beginning on the date of receipt of the dues payment instead of a calendar year. Many memberships were paid towards the end of calendar year 2014 and are now in arrears under the current system. The form reflects changes to incorporate when the fee was paid and the fact that the member must qualify to be a member in accordance with the by-laws.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the revised form and make the yearly dues based on a 365 day basis instead of a calendar year. Also, for those that paid subsequent to the annual meeting of last year, allow them to vote in July of 2015 thereby giving them the opportunity to vote at one annual meeting.

5. Review of all Membership Forms to determine how many want e-mail newsletters instead of snail mail newsletters. We have 192 who wish e-mail newsletters and 78 who wish snail mail. However, not all of these are paid up members of 2015 under current membership rules. Approximately 70 members are currently paid up for 2015 unless we make allowances for those who paid subsequent to last year's annual meeting are allowed to vote in July of this year on any items brought to the table.

RECOMMENDATION: Set up a group mailing to send newsletters via e-mail to those who want it and set up a mailing list for the others. This will save us in postage. Refer to Item #4 above on change in what constitutes a full year's membership.
